## **Important Parent Information**

- School hours are from 8:00 am-2:50 pm
- Breakfast will be served between 7:40am 8:10am
- School hours are the same for Elementary, Middle, and High School
- No student should arrive before 7:40 am
- All students should be dropped off under the breezeway at the front of the office (high school building)
- Medication forms students must have medical forms on file in the school office in order to take medications at school, this includes OTC medicine.
- Check Out/In Policy: Please come to the front office located in the high school building to sign your student out or back in. Our doors will be locked during the school day, please ring the doorbell for assistance.

# DRESS CODE

FCA WILL CONTINUE TO OBSERVE A UNIFORM DRESS CODE. STUDENTS WILL WEAR KHAKI, BLACK, OR NAVY PANTS OR BLUE JEANS. ANY SOLID, COLORED, COLLARED SHIRT WITH FCA ON THE FRONT. SHIRTS HAVE BEEN ORDERED AND CAN BE PURCHASED FOR \$12 THROUGH THE FRONT OFFICE. SHIRTS MAY BE PURCHASED ELSEWHERE AS LONG AS THEY ARE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE DRESS CODE. EMBROIDERED OR SCREEN-PRINTED FCA IS ACCEPTABLE. FCA ADMINISTRATION RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DETERMINE THE APPROPRIATENESS OR INAPPROPRIATENESS OF CLOTHING.

## Required

- Shirts-FCA shirts or FCA-issued outerwear (collared shirts with FCA on the front). Elementary students may wear plain solid color polos.
- Pants Plain black, navy, khaki, or blue jeans. Pants cannot have holes, patches, slits, frays, etc. regardless of the location.
- Shoes Closed-toed (crocs are acceptable).
- Jackets and Coats Plain coats (or sweaters) that button or zip all the way down. No pullovers or hoodies.
- Skirts and shorts same color selection as pants – Must be longer than fingers tips.

#### **Not Allowed**

- Tank tops, spaghetti straps, sleeveless tops, low cut tops, open back or sides, bare midriff (shirts must meet the top of the pants), seethrough, inappropriate messages or symbols, or bedroom attire.
- Hoodies
- Hats, caps, bandanas, toboggans, do-rags, bonnets, scarves, headbands, or picks.
- Jeggings, athletic wear (including basketball shorts), leggings, joggers, spandex, yoga pants, sagging pants, and pajama pants.
- Bedroom shoes, slides, blankets.
- Chains, weapons, or items that look like weapons.
- Cell phones, iPods, electronic devices, earbuds or earphones.

DRESS-DOWN PASSES: STUDENTS MAY WEAR ANY APPROPRIATE SHIRT AND HOODIES. STUDENTS MUST STILL FOLLOW THE "NOT ALLOWED" SECTION FOR DRESS-DOWN DAYS (WITH THE EXCEPTION OF HOODIES). STUDENTS ARE ALLOWED TO DRESS UP (NOT DOWN) FOR AWARDS DAY. THE "NOT ALLOWED" SECTION OF THE DRESS CODE MUST STILL BE FOLLOWED. SPIRIT WEAR (FCA T-SHIRTS & SWEATSHIRTS) CAN BE WORN ON FRIDAYS ONLY WITH REQUIRED PANTS/SHORTS/SKIRTS.

THERE WILL BE OPPORTUNITIES THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL YEAR FOR STUDENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN SPECIAL DRESS DAYS (EXAMPLE: FRIDAYS, 9-11, SPIRIT WEEK, HALLOWEEN, ETC.). THESE OPPORTUNITIES WILL BE ANNOUNCED IN SCHOOL AND EMAILED TO HOUSEPARENTS AND/OR PARENTS. IF STUDENTS DO NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE SPECIAL DRESS DAY, THEN THEY ARE EXPECTED TO WEAR THEIR UNIFORMS. STUDENTS CAN WEAR FCA T-SHIRTS OR SWEATSHIRTS ON FRIDAYS OR THEIR UNIFORM POLOS.

DRESS CODE VIOLATIONS WILL BE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION. UNIFORM INSPECTIONS WILL BE CONDUCTED DAILY BY THE "WELCOMING STAFF" AND/OR THE FIRST-PERIOD TEACHERS. REPEATED VIOLATIONS COULD RESULT IN SUSPENSION.
